What is eLearning?

During an eLearning day, teachers provide/assign instruction and feedback to students virtually, or online. While the school is closed, students need to have access to a computer/tablet/cell phone with internet access.

Lessons and Assignments

Teachers will have Lessons available to students on Google Classroom. Teachers will be accessible via e-mail and Google Classroom (or other method) from 9:00AM-2:00 PM. Assignments should be completed and “turned in” electronically. I-Ready, IXL, and other online programs will be used to help deliver standards based curriculum.

Students without Internet Access

Students without Internet Access have the following options:

- Go to a friend or family member’s house (if travel restrictions allow).
- Communicate with teachers over the phone or text to arrange alternative assignments
- Students can prepare to come to school early or stay late after returning from school to make up all assignments

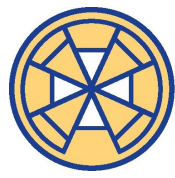
Student Expectations
