Each answer should include a direct quote from this article and an explanation of what it means in your own words. 1) If we can't see or touch soundwaves, how can they damage our ears? 2) How can we protect ourselves from noise induced hearing loss? 3) What is tinnitus?	Watch this short video on transverse and longitudinal waves. Then describe what each type of wave looks like. Don't find a definition (it's in the video, don't worry), but describe what you see in the video of each wave type. This should not be a technical definition. Then, look up three examples of longitudinal and transverse waves. Explain how you personally experience these wave types in your daily lives.	This will help you model what you'll be writing about.
